Intent: The purpose of this agreement is to provide a mechanism for students to transfer up to 24 undergraduate credits or 12 graduate credits to the Crown College School of Online Studies (see Articulation Chart below for exact lists of courses).

Grade Requirements: A grade of at least 2.0 (C or higher) is required for the transfer of LIFT undergraduate courses. A grade of at least 3.0 (B or higher) is required for the transfer of LIFT graduate courses.

Maximum Number of Credits. Up to a maximum of 24 undergraduate credits or 12 graduate credits will be accepted by Crown for transfer credit into one of its accredited Crown College School of Online Studies Degree Programs in accordance with the degree program requirements of the Crown College Catalog in which the student begins enrollment at Crown College as stated in the Articulation Chart.

Residency Requirement (Courses taken at Crown): Undergraduate students must complete 30 of the last 60 credits through Crown including a minimum of 50% of the major or minor core. Graduate students must complete 24 of the last 36 credits through Crown including a minimum of 50% of the major or minor core.

Enrollment Process: Students must go through the Crown institutional application process for the degree program they select. Requirements include completing all forms and submitting all related evidentiary documentation including official transcripts from previously attended institutions. Students should indicate they have potential transfer credit from LIFT.

Payment: Students enrolled at Crown College or transferring credit into Crown College and participating in the LIFT program at CAMP-of-the-WOODS are responsible for Crown College tuition charges for the courses after they enroll in Crown College as a student for one of their degree programs.

Official Transcript: In order to receive transfer credit, students must request an official transcript to be sent to Crown College from LIFT. This transcript must list the courses taken and grades earned. If the student has taken post-secondary courses from other institutions, official transcripts from those institutions are also required. Students who earned credit from other sources such as CLEP, AP, IB, DSST, must request an official transcript from the source of the exam (e.g., College Board for CLEP).

Accreditation: Crown College is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission and currently offers on-campus undergraduate degrees and online undergraduate and graduate degrees. LIFT holds no educational accreditation.

Length of Agreement: This agreement shall be effective from the date of signing through June 30, 2027. Prior to the expiration date, Crown College and LIFT will review the agreement to determine if renewal is desired. If renewal is desired, the curriculum should be reviewed to determine if any changes are needed (based on the most recent catalogs).

Changes to the Curriculum: LIFT will provide in writing information about any changes in its programs or course offerings (e.g. course name, course id, replacement of courses, etc.). Whenever possible, said written notification shall be given at least 30 days prior to such changes going into effect. Changes may result in the need for an updated agreement.
