## Memo of Understanding

Between

**CROWN COLLEGE**

and

**REACH TRAINING INSTITUTE**

In recognition of our shared mission and to enhance our mutual abilities to meet the needs of our students, Crown College, a Minnesota non-profit educational institution, whose address is 8700 College View Drive, Saint Bonifacius, Minnesota 55375 ("Crown"), and Reach Training Institute (RTI) whose administrative address is 1300 Broadway St. NE, Suite 405, Salem Oregon 97301 hereby agree to participate in the Cooperative Initiative on the terms outlined herein.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets the terms, conditions, and responsibilities between the two partners in order to execute this initiative.

### **Statement of Intent**

Crown College and Salem Alliance Church (Salem, OR), dba Reach Training Institute (RTI) desire to come together to provide a pathway for RTI students to receive an online accredited B.S. degree in Global and Cultural Studies with an option to pursue the M.A. in Global Leadership or B.S. in Christian Ministries with an option to pursue an accelerated M.A. in Christian Studies degree.

### **Background**

Crown College background: Crown was founded in 1916 and is a four-year, private Christian college with more than 40 accredited undergraduate and graduate majors. The mission of Crown College is to provide a biblically based education for Christian leadership in The Christian and Missionary Alliance, the church-at-large, and the world.

RTI exists to raise up church leaders and international workers who are debt-free, field-ready, and prepared to take the gospel of Jesus Christ to all the peoples of the world.

## **Academic Agreements and Terms**

### **Academic Agreement**

The two institutions will provide for a blended curriculum involving coursework to be completed through Reach Training Institute (RTI), Crown College, and another regionally accredited institution of higher education. All approved classes taken through RTI will transfer as credit towards an undergraduate degree at Crown College according to the attached articulation agreement. Students transferring credits from other unaccredited institutions having a partnership with Crown College may transfer no more than a total of 80 credits through these partnerships. The blended curriculum in this agreement is designed for students seeking to pursue the B.S. in Christian Ministry or the B.S. in Global and Cultural Studies. Students may elect to add second majors or minors to their program of study, but this may lengthen the time that it takes to complete their program of study. Eligible students in the B. S. in Christian Ministry degree program may apply to participate in the accelerated M. A. in Christian

Studies degree program and eligible students in the B. S. in Global and Cultural Studies degree program may apply to participate in the accelerated M. A. in Global Leadership degree program.

### Academic Terms

1. Students will normally complete their first two years of study through RTI and Chemeketa Community College or another regionally accredited institution of higher education. During this time, RTI will advise students to complete general education courses required by their Crown College degree program. During their final two years of study, students will complete at least 30 of their final 60 credit hours through the School of Online Studies at Crown College. Crown will cooperate with RTI to provide academic advising during this phase of study. A scope and sequence document that outlines the courses to be completed during the four years of this blended curriculum will be reviewed annually by the Crown and RTI advising teams.
2. Before their third year of study, RTI students will apply to study in the Crown College School of Online Studies. This application will include transcripts of previous college coursework and an official transcript from RTI documenting their courses completed to date. RTI will later provide an updated transcript during the student's final semester of study in the blended program. Grades of "C" or higher are required in order for courses to transfer.
3. Students transferring credits from other unaccredited institutions having a partnership with Crown College may transfer no more than a total of 80 credits through these partnerships.
4. Students are encouraged to complete a FERPA agreement that will enable Crown College staff to communicate academic and financial information to RTI.
5. Students who complete all degree requirements will be awarded the earned degree by Crown College.

### Partnership Responsibilities

Crown College will:

1. Send student course schedules and student bills to RTI each term after the student has completed a FERPA agreement that allows RTI to receive the student information.
2. Notify RTI of any changes in degree requirements.
3. Provide an admissions counselor to guide RTI students through the Crown enrollment process.
4. Provide an academic advisor to assist individual RTI students with Crown course registration and degree completion requirements.
5. Provide a lead academic contact.

RTI will:

1. Recruit all students who attend Reach Training Institute.
2. Issue payment to Crown College for student bills associated with the required Crown courses as outlined in the scope and sequence. This payment will not be for general education courses or for course repeats.
3. Send official student transcripts to the registrar office at Crown College.
4. Provide an academic advisor to make sure RTI students take the required RTI courses as outlined in the articulation agreement.
5. Provide a lead academic contact.

### Financial Agreement

1. Crown will guarantee a 50% tuition discount package to all RTI students participating in the approved blended curriculum provided that they apply for financial aid. RTI students will receive a financial award package in which the Pell Grant awarded and other Crown institutional scholarships will contribute toward this 50% tuition discount. Crown will then supplement the Pell Grant with a tuition scholarship so that students are guaranteed a 50% tuition discount package. On occasion, the Federal government may ask students to complete a verification process in order to receive their Pell Grant disbursement. Students who do not complete the verification process will not receive additional scholarships from Crown in order to cover Pell Grant funds which are not disbursed. Students will be responsible to pay their semester bill before they are allowed to register for their next semester's classes at Crown. The 50% tuition discount package does not apply to the fifth year of graduate study for students pursuing the accelerated M.A. in Christian Studies or M.A. Global Leadership.
2. In the event that the Crown College School of Online Studies tuition rate increases or decreases by 5% or more between academic years, both parties will re-evaluate the guaranteed 50% tuition discount package described above in order to maintain the tuition expense and revenue goals associated with this original agreement.
3. Crown College agrees to notify RTI of all Crown College School of Online Studies tuition and fees by April for the following academic year. Crown College agrees to waive the application fee for all RTI students.
4. Staff and attendees of RTI partner schools and affiliated churches who promote Crown Online undergraduate and graduate degree programs that fall outside of the bounds of this agreement will be eligible for a 10% Strategic Partner tuition scholarship. These students must indicate their affiliation with RTI during the application process and complete a Strategic Partner Scholarship application. Students participating in the degree programs associated with this agreement will not be eligible for an additional 10% tuition scholarship.

## Marketing and Advertising

Reach Training Institute and all branch campuses will include a statement about this Cooperative Agreement with Crown College in their catalog and on their web page. In addition, Salem Alliance Church and other churches cooperating with RTI branch campuses agree to promote Crown College undergraduate and graduate degree programs to their broader constituency. Crown College will include a statement about this Cooperative Agreement with Reach Training Institute on their web page.

## Accreditation

Crown College has sole responsibility for accreditation matters between Crown College and The Higher Learning Commission (HLC). The College of Missionary Aviation assumes no responsibility for the present or ongoing accreditation of the online degrees offered by Crown College. If Crown College learns of any issues with the HLC that may affect accreditation, it will notify the College of Missionary Aviation immediately so there will be no danger of CMA offering misleading information to incoming

students. Crown College is not in any way accrediting or able to accredit the College of Missionary Aviation courses and the specified courses will only articulate for academic credit into Crown College.

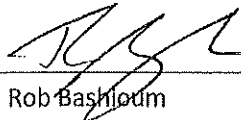
**Indemnity**

- 1. Crown agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold the College of Missionary Aviation and its licensees, assignees, officers, directors, agents, and employees harmless against all costs, expenses, and losses (Including reasonable attorney fees and costs) incurred through claims of third parties against Crown College that may result from any default of Crown College concerning this MOU.
- 2. the College of Missionary Aviation agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold Crown College and its licensees, assignees, officers, directors, agents, and employees harmless against all costs, expenses, and losses (Including reasonable attorney fees and costs) incurred through claims of third parties against the College of Missionary Aviation that may result from any default of the College of Missionary Aviation concerning this MOU.

**Terms of Agreement**


- 1. This agreement shall be effective through June 30th, 2024 and may be reviewed, amended, and endorsed thereafter.
- 2. In the event that either educational partner wishes to terminate this agreement, they agree to notify the other party prior to January 1<sup>st</sup> in any year to be effective the following July 1<sup>st</sup>. In the event of a termination, Crown will partner with RTI to facilitation the degree completion for RTI students who are currently enrolled through Crown Online as a part of this agreement.

**Grade Requirements:** A grade of at least 2.0 (C or higher) is required for the transfer of **undergraduate courses** completed by Reach Training Institute students.

**Maximum Number of Credits.** Up to a maximum of **74 credits** will be accepted by Crown for transfer credit in the **Crown College School of Online Studies** in accordance with the degree program requirements (B.S. in Christian Ministry or B.S. in Global Cultural Studies) of the Crown College Catalog in which the student begins enrollment at Crown College as stated in the Articulation Chart.

**Residency Requirement (Courses taken at Crown):** Undergraduate students must complete 30 of the last 60 credits through Crown including a minimum of 50% of the major or minor core.

**Enrollment Process:** Students must go through the Crown institutional application process for the degree program they select. Requirements include completing all forms and submitting all related

evidentiary documentation including official transcripts from previously attended institutions. Students should indicate they have potential transfer credit from Reach Training Institute.

**Official Transcript:** In order to receive transfer credit, students must request an official transcript to be sent to Crown College from Reach Training Institute. This transcript must list the courses taken and grades earned. If the student has taken post-secondary courses from other institutions, official transcripts from those institutions are also required. Students who earned credit from other sources such as CLEP, AP, IB, DSST, must request an official transcript from the source of the exam (e.g., College Board for CLEP).

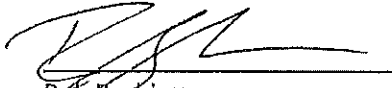
**Accreditation:** Crown College is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission and currently offers on-campus undergraduate degrees and online undergraduate and graduate degrees. Reach Training Institute holds no educational accreditation.

**Length of Agreement:** This agreement shall be effective from the date of signing through June 30, 2024. Prior to the expiration date, Crown College and Reach Training Institute will review the agreement to determine if renewal is desired. If renewal is desired, the curriculum should be reviewed to determine if any changes are needed (based on the most recent catalogs).


**Changes to the Curriculum:** Reach Training Institute will provide in writing information about any changes in its programs or course offerings (e.g. course name, course id, replacement of courses, etc.). Whenever possible, said written notification shall be given at least 30 days prior to such changes going into effect. Changes may result in the need for an updated agreement.

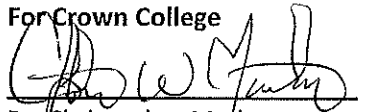
